ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

At their regular meeting on March 3, 2008, the Judges of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan approved proposed amendments to LR 83.20(d), Attorney Admission, Procedure for Admission, for publication and referral to the Court's Local Rules Advisory Committee. The Court also voted to approve a revised Attorney Application for Admission.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT effective immediately, the following procedure will govern the attorney admission process pending final approval of the amendments to LR 83.20(d):


An applicant for admission to the bar of this court must pay the fee established by the court and complete the application provided by the clerk. The following information must be included in the application:

- (1) applicant's name, firm/agency name (if applicable), office address, email address, office telephone and fax numbers;
- (2) the date of admission for each jurisdiction where the applicant has been admitted to practice and appropriate I.D. number;
- (3) whether the applicant has ever been held in contempt, or the subject of an order of discipline as defined in LR 83.22(a)(1). If so, the applicant must state the facts and the final disposition of each such instance;
- (4) whether the applicant is not in compliance with an order of a court or been convicted of a crime. If so, the applicant must state the facts and the final disposition of each instance; and
- (5) any other name under which the applicant has received legal education or has practiced or been licensed and the periods during which the names were used.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the procedures contained in LR 83.20(d)(2) and (d)(3) remain in effect.
