ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Local Rule 83.11(b)(4) and Administrative Order 06-AO-015 govern the redistribution and reassignment of civil cases in this Court.


Currently, including the chief judge and senior judges, there are 19 full civil caseloads in the Southern Division. The average number of pending civil cases for a full-caseload Southern Division judge is 167. This number is calculated by adding the pending civil cases for general civil cases and special civil cases for all district judges as of December 31, 2019 (3,182 cases) and dividing by 19.

IT IS ORDERED that the clerk will proceed, as provided in Section B of Administrative Order 06-AO-015, to identify by random method 152 cases, 8 cases from each full-caseload judge, and the appropriate number of cases from each senior district judge who has less than a full caseload. For the purpose of special civil cases, Judge Thomas L. Ludington will be included in this calculation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the magistrate judges previously assigned to these cases will not be changed because of the reassignment of these civil cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notices of reassignment in each case will be sent to attorneys of record and parties not represented by counsel as soon as practicable.
