**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

District Judge Stephanie Dawkins Davis was appointed by President Joseph Biden to the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals on June 14, 2022. Pursuant to LR 83.11 and LCrR 57.10, her civil and criminal caseloads will be reassigned, accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the clerk will randomly reassign all pending civil cases (excluding social security cases and special civil cases as defined by LR 83.11(a)) to the district judges in the Southern Division.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk will randomly reassign all social security and special civil cases to the district judges in the Eastern District of Michigan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall reassign all pending non-fugitive criminal cases to Judge Shalina D. Kumar.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the magistrate judges already assigned to these cases will not be changed because of the reassignment and any pending referrals shall remain in effect unless vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that text-only notices of reassignment will be entered in each case and served on the parties not represented by counsel as soon as practicable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that both civil and criminal post judgment matters will be reassigned as necessary in accordance with LR 83.11 (b)(8) and LCrR 57.10(b)(5).
