- LCR 57.10, Assignment and Reassignment of Criminal Cases to Judges
- LR 77.2, Presiding Judge

LCrR 57.10 Assignment and Reassignment of Criminal Cases to Judges

(d) Superseding Indictments or Informations.

(3) Superseding indictments and informations shall not be filed in closed cases or cases where the last defendant has pleaded guilty and is awaiting sentencing.

LR 77.2 Presiding Judge

(f) Flint. In Flint, the more senior resident judge will establish the presiding judge calendar, which will designate one of the presiding judge is the resident district judges at that court location as the presiding judge for the period. The presiding judge normally acts for designated one-week periods. If that judge is not available, the matter will be referred

by the Clerk's Office to the presiding judge in Detroit.
