Briefing Requirements and Hearing Dates

- 2) The motions to dismiss in *Carthan v. Snyder*, Case No. 16-cv-10444 will be briefed and heard on the following schedule, as proposed by plaintiffs and unopposed by defendants:

- b. Responses filed by: February 13, 2018
- c. Replies filed by: March 20, 2018
- d. Hearing to be held on: May 10, 2018 at 10:00 A.M.
- e. The parties will submit a proposed stipulated order regarding page limits for the motion to dismiss briefing on or before **November 21, 2017**.

The parties are to submit proposed agenda items by December 22, 2017, and the Court will issue an agenda for that status conference by December 28, 2017.
