Federal Pro Se Legal Assistance Clinic

Clinic hours: Monday, Wednesday, Friday from 1-5 p.m.

The Clinic will provide no cost limited scope legal representation to low-income pro se litigants (i.e., litigants who do not have an attorney). Clinic services are limited to non-prisoner pro se litigants.

Clinic services may include:

1. Review of cases not yet filed for federal court jurisdiction
2. Review of filed cases for federal court jurisdiction
3. Clarifying legal claims and amending the complaint, if necessary
4. Assistance completing pro se forms
5. Legal advice regarding the law, court rules and procedures
6. Explanation of court orders, court pleadings, and discovery issues
7. Limited legal research and assistance with drafting
8. Assistance bringing and opposing motions
9. Assistance with preparing for case management conferences, hearings, settlement conferences, mediations and other court appearances
