On January 25, 2022, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan will present a Mass Swearing-In Ceremony via Zoom. The ceremony is open to all attorneys not admitted to practice in this Court who are registered for the New Lawyers' Seminar.

Applicants for admission to the bar of the Eastern District of Michigan must register online at pacer.uscourts.gov and submit during the registration process the following documents:

- Original Certificate of Good Standing issued within the last 30 days from a court of record identified in the application (e.g. Michigan Supreme Court)
- Attorney Admission Terms and Conditions Form
- If applicable, a completed Disciplinary Disclosures Form disclosing previous disciplinary issues and a completed Declaration of Sponsor Form in compliance with Local Rule 83.20(d)(3)

* A Declaration of Sponsor is not required for the Mass Swearing-In (unless required under the third bullet above).

Application Fee

The fee to apply for admission to the Eastern District of Michigan is \$307.00. Once the required documentation has been verified, an email will be sent to the applicant with a link to pay the admission fee.

Cut-off Date

All applications and the required documentation must be submitted via PACER by January 10, 2022 in order to be assured participation in the Mass Swearing-In.
