

FILING DISCOVERY

The Court does not accept discovery material in accordance with Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 5(d) and Eastern District of Michigan Local Rule 26.2.



Depositions, interrogatories, requests for production of documents, requests for admission and responses to such discovery material **shall not be filed with the Clerk except**:

When it provides factual support of a motion, response, or reply.
 The party relying on the material must file it as an exhibit or attachment to the motion, response, or reply.

Or

 When it is used during a trial, hearing or other miscellaneous proceeding. The party relying on the material must file it at the beginning of the trial, hearing or proceeding or as allowed by the Court.

Or

When not previously filed with the Clerk and the discovery
material is necessary for an appeal in a case. The party
maintaining custody of the discovery material shall file it with the
Clerk either on stipulation of the parties or by order of the Court.
