

SEARCHING FOR EVENTS

If unsure of which event to use when filing a document, use the **Search** feature.



INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Click **Search** and enter a keyword.

For example, to find the event to file an **Objection to Report and Recommendation** in a **civil** case, search for the keyword **"objection."**



Step 2: A list of events will be displayed. Choose the event from the list.
Click the link to begin filing the document.

For example, to file an **Objection to Report and Recommendation** in a **civil case**, click the event located under the heading **Civil Events → Other Answers**.



Pay **careful attention** because both civil and criminal events are displayed and have similar names.
