AND OTHER COMMUNICATION DEVICES BY ATTORNEYS  
AT FEDERAL COURTHOUSE IN FLINT, MICHIGAN**

This order is entered pursuant to E.D. Mich. LR 83.31(f)(3), Conduct in Federal Court Facilities, District Judge Authority, that states in part:

A district judge located in a court facility at a duty station away from the Theodore Levin Courthouse in Detroit, Michigan may make appropriate orders regulating the possession and use of phones in the buildings in which he or she presides.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT possession of phones by attorneys is allowed in the Federal Courthouse in Flint, Michigan as prescribed in LR 83.31(f): and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT in accordance with LR 83.31(f)(2)(A), phones may only be used in the following designated areas of the Federal Courthouse in Flint:

Room 103, located on the first floor of the Federal Courthouse.
