Health Screening Self-Assessment

The Court is committed to ensuring public health and safety during your visit. Please be aware of Administrative Order 22-AO-014, instructing persons with an active diagnosis of COVID-19, persons experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and persons with COVID-19 exposure in their households to not enter the Courthouses.

Accordingly, you should not enter the Courthouses if you can answer yes to any of the following:

- 1) Are you COVID-19 positive?
- 2) Have you had close contact or exposure within the last 10 days to someone, in particular within the same household who tested positive for COVID-19?
- 3) **In the last 10 days**, have you experienced any of the following symptoms not attributed to a known medical condition:

- If you are scheduled to meet with a Pretrial Services Officer, please contact Pretrial Services at (313) 234-5300;
- If you are scheduled to meet with a Probation Officer, please contact Probation at (313) 234-5400;
- If you are a juror, please contact the Jury Department at (313) 234-5085;
- For District Court matters, please contact (313) 234-5000;
