ORDER RE EXHIBITS ACCOMPANYING A DEFENDANT'S 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A) MOTION FOR COMPASSIONATE RELEASE AND REPLY, AND THE GOVERNMENT'S RESPONSE

The Court orders that a party filing exhibits in a Motion for Compassionate Release case must:

- (1) Number all pages contained in the entire exhibit packet sequentially, from the first page of the first exhibit to the last page of the last exhibit.
- (2) Provide an index identifying (a) each exhibit, as a letter or number (e.g., "A", "B", or "1", "2"), (b) the specific category of each exhibit, e.g., prison medical records, personal medical record, BOP disciplinary record, BOP education/employment records, family letters, etc., and (c) the specific sequential page number(s) applicable to each exhibit.

(3)	As to all page-numbered specific exhibits you want the Court to
	consider, highlight the relevant material on that page. This is essential
	because many of the medical records contain tiny print.
