AND RULE 26 JOINT DISCOVERY PLAN DEADLINE**

Take notice that the above-entitled case has been set for a Rule 16 Scheduling Conference on _____ at _____, before the Honorable Stephanie Dawkins Davis, U.S. District Court, 600 Church Street, Courtroom 108, Flint, MI 48502.

Before the Scheduling Conference, pursuant to Rule 26(f)(2), the attorneys of record are jointly responsible for the preparation of a discovery plan that includes the information identified in Rule 26(f)(3) and may also include reference to the issues listed in Rule 16(c)(2) if relevant. Rule 26(f)(1) requires that the parties confer no later than 21 days before the scheduling conference and develop a proposed discovery plan. This plan must be submitted to the Court at least three days before the date of the Rule 16 Scheduling Conference date identified above.
