ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

LCrR 6.1(a) provides:

All grand juries are under the direct supervision of the Court. The Chief Judge shall act for the Court. The Chief Judge, by Administrative Order, may designate District Judges to act for the Court.

LCrR 6.1(d) provides:

. . . All miscellaneous matters regarding grand juries sitting in Bay City or Flint shall be assigned to the District Judge designated by the Chief Judge to act for the Court in supervising the grand jury in that place of holding court.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to LCrR 6.1(a) and (d) and until further order of the Court, that the District Judges regularly holding court in Bay City and Flint are designated to act for the Court in supervising the grand juries at their respective place of holding court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the District Judges regularly holding court in Bay City and Flint may act for the Court in the absence or unavailability of the other in supervising the grand juries in Bay City and Flint.

This administrative order supersedes Administrative Orders 95-AO-039 (Flint) and 99-AO-039 (Bay City).
