
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

At their regular meeting on November 5, 2007, the Judges of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan approved the continuation of a practice which has been in place since October 2001 regarding mail and packages addressed to federal court facilities:

- (1) All mail and packages addressed to any office within a federal court facility are subject to physical and/or x-ray examination by the United States Marshals Service.
- (2) Except as provided in (3), sealed envelopes brought by courier may not be delivered to any office within a federal court facility. They must be given to a court security officer for processing in that facility's mail room.
- (3) Documents that are sealed and accompanied by a court order authorizing the sealing may be delivered to the Clerk's Office.
