ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

At their regular meeting on June 2, 2008, the Judges of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan authorized the Chief Judge to enter this administrative order.

Stylistic amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure took effect on December 1, 2007. These amendments affect references contained within the Local Rules for the Eastern District of Michigan.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that effective immediately the following changes to federal rule citations will be made to the Local Rules for the Eastern District of Michigan:

- ▶ E.D.Mich. LR 7.1(a)(1): The reference to Fed.R.Civ.P. 6(b)(1) is changed to Fed.R.Civ.P. 6(b)(1)(A)
- ▶ E.D.Mich. LR 11.1: The reference to "subdivision (b)" is changed to "Rule 11(b)", and the reference to Fed.R.Civ.P.11(c)(2)(A) is changed to Fed.R.Civ.P. 11(c)(5)(A).
- ▶ E.D.Mich. LR 16.2(a): The reference to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3) in the third sentence is changed to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(B).
- ▶ E.D.Mich. LR 16.2(b)(7): The reference to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3) is changed to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(B).
- ▶ E.D.Mich. LR 16.2(b)(8): The reference to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(A) and (B) is changed to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(A)(i) and (ii).
- ▶ E.D. Mich. LR 16.2(b)(9): The reference to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(C) is changed to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(3)(A)(iii).


