## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This administrative order is a supplement to Administrative Order 21-AO-009 and provides updated guidance related to courthouse entry screening processes. All other provisions in Administrative Order 21-AO-009 remain in effect.

In the interest of public health and safety, and after consideration of public health guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, State of Michigan, and other public health authorities, the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan hereby orders that, effective immediately and until this order is rescinded,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that every person who comes to one of the courthouses of the Eastern District of Michigan must pass through the following entry screening process:

- Have their temperature taken using a contactless thermometer. A person with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will not be permitted to enter the courthouse.
- After completion of a temperature check:
  - Staff may enter the building through the regular screening process.
  - Non-staff will be directed by court security to review the list of questions about COVID-19 status and possible recent COVID-19 exposure and asked to provide yes/no responses. If responses are negative, non-staff may enter the building through the regular screening process. If responses are positive, persons will not be permitted to enter the courthouse.
- Wear a mask that covers the person's nose and mouth. If a person does not have a mask, they will be provided one.

This order will remain in place until further notice.
