This order is entered pursuant to E.D. Mich. LR 83.31(f)(2), Conduct in Federal Court Facilities, Policy Governing Attorneys.

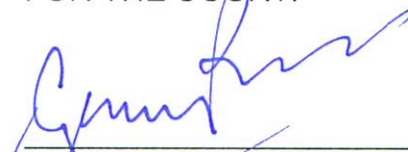

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT in accordance with LR 83.31(f)(2)(A), phones may only be used in the following designated areas of the Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse in Flint:

Room 103 (Attorney Conference Room), located on the first floor; and

Room G-25 (Vending Room), located in the basement.
