ORDER ALLOWING DESTRUCTION OF IMPLANTS

This matter having come on the DCC Litigation Facility, Inc.'s Motion for Order Allowing Destruction of Implants, the Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel having no objection to the motion, and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Dow Corning may destroy, by recycling or incineration, approximately 95,000 breast implants along with an unknown number or partially manufactured implants, quantities of implant components and materials, and miscellaneous paraphernalia that was used or generated in the implant manufacturing process which ceased in 1992. The implants to be destroyed are models that were in production when the manufacturing process was shut down in 1992. The models and numbers of implants which Dow Corning is allowed to destroy are as follows.

Silastic® II Single Lumen — 48,547 Silastic® II Double Lumen — 3,960 Silastic® MSI Single Lumen — 39,113 Silastic® MSI Double Lumen — 3,386

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dow Corning will retain 10,000 samples of the four models of implants listed above. In addition, the company will store its entire inventory of older models of implants consisting of approximately 5,200 units.
