**AGENDA FOR NOVEMBER 15, 2017 STATUS CONFERENCE**

The Court will hold a status conference in these cases on November 15, 2017 at 10:00 A.M. in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The agenda will be as follows:

**A. Administrative Issues**

***Briefing Requirements and Hearing Dates***

The Court hereby sets the following briefing requirements and hearing dates:

- 1) Leo A. Daly's motion to dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction will be heard on **April 16, 2018 at 2:00 P.M.**
- 2) The motions to dismiss in *Carthan v. Snyder*, Case No. 16-cv-10444 will be briefed and heard on the following schedule, as proposed by plaintiffs and unopposed by defendants:

- a. Motions filed by: **December 1, 2017**
- b. Responses filed by: **February 13, 2018**
- c. Replies filed by: **March 20, 2018**
- d. Hearing to be held on: **May 10, 2018 at 10:00 A.M.**
- e. The parties will submit a proposed stipulated order regarding page limits for the motion to dismiss briefing on or before **November 21, 2017**.

### ***Scheduling of Next Status Conference***

The next status conference for all Flint Water cases will be held on **January 4, 2018 at 2:00 P.M.** The parties are to submit proposed agenda items by **December 22, 2017**, and the Court will issue an agenda for that status conference by **December 28, 2017**. The parties will submit all proposed agenda items on Case No. 16-cv-10444. All proposed agenda items for individual cases will be submitted by individual liaison counsel in Case No. 16-cv-10444.

### ***Defendants' Proposed Executive Committee Structure***

The Court will discuss defendants' proposed executive committee structure (Case No. 16-cv-10444, Dkt. 241).

### ***Class Action Meet and Confer Report***

The Court will discuss the meet and confer report interim class counsel for plaintiffs and defense counsel are to file on November 13, 2017, particularly any areas of contention or disagreement identified in the report.

### ***Transcript Ordering Protocol***

The Court will discuss transcript ordering protocol for status conferences, hearings, and all other on the record proceedings.

## **B. Substantive Issues**

### ***Expired Summonses***

Counsel in Case Nos. 17-cv-11392 and 17-cv-11481 should be prepared to discuss expired summonses as to the Veolia defendants, Liane Shekter-Smith, Adam Rosenthal, Stephen Busch, Patrick Cook, Michael Prysby, and Edward Kurtz.

### ***Motion for Leave to File a Master Individual Complaint***

The Court will hold oral argument on the motion for leave to file a master individual complaint. (Case No. 17-cv-10164, Dkt. 82.)

The Court will not hold oral argument on the issues related to preliminary discovery until the briefing previously ordered is completed.
