



**NOTICE: REQUESTS FOR EXCESS FEES
AND SERVICES FOR CJA COUNSEL**

Effective June 8, 2026, the Court issued an administrative order outlining new procedures for requesting excess fees and services for Criminal Justice Act (CJA) Counsel. In non-budgeted cases, ex parte motions are no longer required to be filed in CM/ECF for excess attorney compensation or expert funds. Additionally, ex parte motions are not required to be filed on the docket to establish a case budget.

These revised procedures are part of a one-year pilot program which will be reviewed for possible renewal.
