Standing Orders; Magistrate Judge jurisdiction

- **i. Standing orders.** The court does not have standing orders or other special pleading requirements for class actions or other civil claims, but may issue case-specific orders to clarify pleadings as required.
- **ii. Magistrate Judge jurisdiction.** The court will consider the parties' unanimous consent to permit the assigned Magistrate Judge to assume full jurisdiction pursuant to <u>28 USC § 636(c)</u> and <u>Fed.R.Civ.P. 73</u>. Counsel should use the standard <u>consent form</u> if unanimous agreement to that effect is present.
